Director's Notes



Welcome everyone to Geneva High School's production of *A Midsummer Night's Dream*! Why is it that after four centuries, his works are regarded as some of the greatest plays ever written? The answer is simple: Shakespeare understood the human experience. Perhaps better than anyone before him (or since!), Shakespeare realized what it was to be human - our loves, our losses, our joys, our desires. Couple this understanding with his complex plots

and character development and it's easy to understand how he has become such a fixture of our popular culture.

Although he wrote this play about halfway through his theatrical career, I believe it to be his best up to that time. The humor is grandiose; the plot is hilarious and ridiculous. The caution of doing a Shakespeare performance is that "the language is too hard to understand." Granted, Shakespeare writes in verse using some words no longer a part of our modern vernacular. But, with a little focus from the audience and a clear presentation from the actors, I believe it's easier to grasp than most people think. (I am also entertained by the argument that "we don't talk that way anymore" as if people in Elizabethan England walked around rhyming.)

I hope you enjoy Shakespeare's most popular comedy - a tale of mistaken identity, sexual freedom, coming-of-age woes, and the desire to be popular. But most of all, Shakespeare knows we can all relate to how often love is blind and how it can compel us to do some crazy things.

Feel free to peruse the plot synopsis before the start of the show if you think that will assist in your enjoyment of the performance!

And as always, thank you for your continued support of the performing arts!

Synopsis


Act 1

Hermia is engaged to Demetrius against her will. She wants to marry the man she loves, Lysander. Her father, Egeus, refuses and asks Duke Theseus and his bride-to-be Hippolyta to enact the law of Athens - either she does as he says or she is put to death. To avoid this fate, Hermia and Lysander decide to run away and let their friend Helena know of their plan. Helena, however, is in love with Demetrius and betrays her friends' secret plan in order to try to win his favor. Elsewhere in Athens, a group of workmen decide to put on an amateur play to present on the Duke's wedding night.

In the forest outside of Athens, the fairies are witness to an argument long since brewing between their king and queen, Oberon and Titania. It seems Oberon fancies Hippolyta, and Titania has eyes for Theseus. To punish his wife for her independent attitude, Oberon sends his servant Puck for a magic flower whose juice acts as a love potion and plots to use it on his wife. While Puck searches for the flower, Oberon witnesses Demetrius mistreat Helena and decides Demetrius should also get a dose of the love potion.

As Oberon drops the love potion in Titania's eyes, he sends Puck to do the same to Demetrius. But Puck instead finds Lysander (fleeing through the forest with Hermia), and mistaking the two youths, he uses the potion on the wrong man. When Lysander awakes, the magic makes him fall in love with Helena, and he abandons Hermia in the wood.

In the meantime, the Mechanical workmen make their way to the forest to rehearse their play. Puck happens upon them, and feeling mischievous, turns Nick Bottom's head into that of a donkey. As the Mechanicals retreat in terror, Titania wakes up and - because of the magic herb - falls in love with the donkey-headed Bottom, leading him to her bower.




Synopsis

Act 2

Oberon realizes Puck's mistake and uses the magic love flower on Demetrius in an attempt to remedy the situation, but after Demetrius wakes, he too first sees Helena. Now, both men who loved Hermia at the start of the play fight each other over Helena. As chaos envelopes the four lovers, Oberon decided enough is enough. He instructs Puck to lead the four quarreling lovers astray so they can each be put to sleep and the remedy applied to Lysander. Oberon also decides to free Titania from the charm and to make peace with his wife.

The four lovers are found sleeping by Theseus, Egeus and Hippolyta - and after Demetrius (still under the spell) declares his newfound love for Helena - Theseus decides the four shall join him on his wedding day and all three couples be wed. Bottom, also freed from the magic donkey head, wakes and returns to his friends who learn their play is up for consideration.

At the wedding reception, Theseus attributes the four young lovers' lack of memory from the night to the craziness and spirit of love. As the guests settle in for entertainment, Philostrate - the master of ceremonies - introduces the Mechanicals who perform their play (terribly, of course) but Theseus rewards them because he realizes their good intentions. As everyone retires for the night, the reconciled Oberon and Titania bless the newlyweds with lifelong happiness. Lastly, Puck addresses the audience and warns us that everything we've just witnessed may have been A Midsummer Night's Dream.




